

Competitive Teams – Livestock Judging Opportunities

The Wildcat Extension District will provide our competitive livestock judging teams with multiple opportunities throughout the year to practice their skills and increase their ability to compete at the top level. Eligibility requirements to compete are detailed in our Wildcat District 4-H Policy Document and covered during our required competitive teams orientation meeting each Fall.
